Sec. 275m. (1) Each public university that receives an appropriation in section 236 shall, before a qualifying student's decision deadline to accept the university's offer of admission to the university, provide a financial cost and aid disclosure form to the qualifying student with the student's initial financial aid

- 6 (ii) The university's cohort of graduates who graduated 5 years

- 8 (g) If the qualifying student has declared a major or enrolled 9 in a particular school at the university, both of the following:
- 10 (i) The income range between the twenty-fifth and seventy-fifth
 11 percentiles for the university's most recent cohort of graduates
