- 1 (2) School districts, intermediate school districts, and 2 public school academies shall provide the notice described in 3 subsection (1) to all of the following individuals:
- 4 (a) School personnel employed by or at a school operated by
 5 the school district, intermediate school district, or public school
 6 academy.
- 7 (b) Students enrolled in the school district, intermediate 8 school district, or public school academy.
- 9 (c) Parents and legal guardians of the students described in 10 subdivision (b).
- 11 (3) The board of a school district or intermediate school
 12 district or board of directors of a public school academy shall
 13 implement a policy to educate the individuals described in
