## **HOUSE BILL NO. 6209**

November 26, 2024, Introduced by Rep. Skaggs and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1973 PA 116, entitled

"An act to provide for the protection of children through the licensing and regulation of child care organizations; to provide for the establishment of standards of care for child care organizations; to prescribe powers and duties of certain departments of this state and adoption facilitators; to provide penalties; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

(MCL 722.111 to 722.128) by adding section 16a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 16a. (1) Beginning on the effective date of the

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- 1 amendatory act that added this section, an operator of a child care
- 2 center, group child care home, or family child care home shall
- 3 maintain, on its premises, a record of the up-to-date immunization
- 4 rates for children in the care of and staff members of the child
- 5 care center, group child care home, or family child care home.
- 6 (2) Beginning June 1, 2026, each child care center receiving
- 7 more than 12 minor children shall comply with all of the following
- 8 concerning public reporting of the immunization status of the minor
- 9 children in its care:
- 10 (a) Provide to the parent or legal guardian of each minor
- 11 child enrolled in the child care center information concerning the
- 12 immunization status of the minor children enrolled in the child
- 13 care center. The information required to be provided under this
- 14 subdivision includes the total number of minor children enrolled in
- 15 each level of care in the child care center, the total number of
- 16 minor children in each level of care in the child care center on
- 17 whom the child care center has been provided documentation of up-
- 18 to-date immunizations, and the total number of minor children in
- 19 each level of care in the child care center on whom the child care
- 20 center has been provided a statement that no immunization has been
- 21 obtained or will be obtained due to religious conviction or other
- 22 objection to immunization.
- 23 (b) Post all of the information required under subdivision (a)
- 24 on the child care center's public website, with a link from the
- 25 homepage, if the child care center has a public website.
- 26 (c) Post a paper notice containing all of the information
- 27 required under subdivision (a) in the main reception area of the
- 28 child care center in a location within the plain view of the
- 29 public.

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- 1 (3) The information required under subsection (2) (a) must be 2 provided by sending email to the email address the child care 3 center has on record for the parent or legal guardian or, if the 4 child care center does not have an email address on record, by 5 United States mail to the mailing address on record for the parent 6 or legal guardian.
- 7 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days 8 after the date it is enacted into law.
