## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 1586a. (1) The school officials of a public school shall consider up to 5 absences due to an illness that impacts a pupil's mental or behavioral health to be excused absences, regardless of whether or not the pupil provides a medical note for the absences.

(2) A pupil must be given the opportunity to make up any

- school work that he or she missed during an absence described in subsection (1).
- 3 (3) If a pupil is absent for 2 or more days due to an illness 4 described in subsection (1), the school officials of the public 5 school in which the pupil is enrolled may, as determined by the 6 board of the school district or intermediate school district or 7 board of directors of the public school academy in which the pupil 8 is enrolled, refer the pupil to the appropriate school personnel.
- 9 (4) As used in this section, "medical note" means a note
  10 issued by a mental health professional as that term is defined in
  11 section 100b of the mental health code, 1974 PA 258, MCL 330.1100b.
