## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 145h. (1) A person shall not intentionally or knowingly
- 2 harass, abuse, threaten, compel, force, coerce, or exploit the
- 3 vulnerability of a vulnerable adult in a manner that causes the
- 4 vulnerable adult to provide that person, or any other person,
- 5 sexually explicit visual material.
- 6 (2) A person who violates subsection (1) is guilty of a

- 1 misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 93 days or
- 2 a fine of not more than \$500.00, or both.
- 3 (3) As used in this section:
- 4 (a) "Sexually explicit visual material" means that term as
- 5 defined in section 145e.
- 6 (b) "Vulnerable adult" means that term as defined in section
- 7 145m.
- 8 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 9 after the date it is enacted into law.
