## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 462g. (1) The testimony of a victim is not required in a
- 2 prosecution under this chapter. However, if a victim testifies,
- 3 that testimony need not be corroborated.
- 4 (2) Expert testimony as to the behavioral patterns of human
- ${f 5}$  trafficking victims and the manner in which a human trafficking

- 1 victim's behavior may deviate from societal expectations is
- 2 admissible as evidence in court in a prosecution under this chapter
- 3 if the expert testimony is otherwise admissible under the rules of
- 4 evidence and laws of this state.
- 5 (3) An individual must not be excused from attending and
- 6 testifying or producing any books, papers, or other documents
- 7 before a court or magistrate upon an investigation, proceeding, or
- 8 trial for a violation of this chapter on the grounds that the
- 9 testimony or evidence may tend to degrade or incriminate the
- 10 individual. Truthful testimony, evidence, or other truthful
- 11 information compelled under this section and any information
- 12 derived directly or indirectly from that truthful testimony,
- 13 evidence, or other truthful information must not be used against
- 14 the witness in a criminal case, except for impeachment purposes or
- 15 in a prosecution for perjury or otherwise failing to testify or
- 16 produce evidence as required.
