A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled $\mbox{"The social welfare act,"}$

by amending section 110a (MCL 400.110a), as added by 2018 PA 220.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 110a. (1) Beginning in the fiscal year that ends
- 2 September 30, 2019, and annually after that, the department shall
- 3 allocate not less than \$26,000,000.00 of its general fund
- 4 appropriation to a rural hospital access pool to assist sole
- 5 community hospitals , critical access hospitals, and rural

- 1 hospitals with providing services to low-income residents.
- (2) All of the following apply to a payment from the ruralhospital access pool:
- 4 (a) \$7,978,300.00 shall be is proportionately divided annually
 5 among sole community hospitals and rural hospitals that provide
 6 obstetrical care to Medicaid beneficiaries, based on the proportion
 7 of Medicaid deliveries performed during the second immediately
 8 preceding fiscal year.
- 9 (b) The balance remaining in the rural hospital access pool
 10 after distribution made under subdivision (a) shall be is annually
 11 allocated as follows:

- (i) Payments shall are first be allocated to reimburse sole community hospitals , critical access hospitals, and rural hospitals for unreimbursed and incurred costs for services delivered to fee for service inpatient and outpatient Medicaid beneficiaries as reported during the second immediately preceding fiscal year cost reporting period.
- (ii) Money remaining in the rural hospital access pool after all distributions are made under subparagraph (i) shall be is allocated based on each sole community hospital's , critical access hospital's, and rural hospital's proportion of Medicaid managed care outpatient payments for services performed during the second immediately preceding fiscal year.
- (c) Notwithstanding subdivisions (a) and (b), no a hospital shall **not** receive more than 10% of the total funding available under the rural hospital access pool in any 1 fiscal year.

 28 that complies with all federal requirements necessary to ensure the
 29 maximum amount of federal matching funds is obtained.

- 8 (i) Has 50 or fewer staffed beds.
- 9 (ii) Is located within a county with a population of not more than $\frac{165,000}{195,000}$ and within a city, village, or township with a population of not more than 15,000 based on the $\frac{2010}{2020}$ federal decennial census.
