THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act may be cited as the "promotion of
 governmental services act".
- 3 Sec. 3. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Local government" means a county, city, village, or5 township.
- 6 (b) "State agency" means a department, board, commission,
- 7 office, agency, authority, or other unit of state government.

Sec. 5. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a state agency or local government that offers any service to residents of this state may not use the word "free" to promote the service.
