## **SENATE BILL NO. 744**

March 06, 2024, Introduced by Senators MCDONALD RIVET and POLEHANKI and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1937 (Ex Sess) PA 4, entitled

"An act relative to continuing tenure of office of certificated teachers in public educational institutions; to provide for probationary periods; to regulate discharges or demotions; to provide for resignations and leaves of absence; to create a state tenure commission and to prescribe the powers and duties thereof; and to prescribe penalties for violation of the provisions of this act,"

by amending section 3b (MCL 38.83b), as amended by 2023 PA 225.

- 11 probationary period, the teacher is considered to have successfully

- 15 effective before July 1, 2024, on 3 consecutive of the teacher's
- 16 year-end performance evaluations, including the year-end

- 18 period, under section 1249 of the revised school code, 1976 PA 451,
- 19 MCL 380.1249, and has completed at least 4 full school years of
