27 PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

28 GENERAL SECTIONS

Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state

constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources under part 1 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2024 is \$2,250,000.00 and total state spending from state sources to be paid to local units of government is \$0.00.

Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized under this part and part 1 and the departments, commissions, boards, offices, and programs for which appropriations are made under this part and part 1 are subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594.

Sec. 203. If the state administrative board, acting under section 3 of 1921 PA 2, MCL 17.3, transfers funds from an amount appropriated under this act, the legislature may, by a concurrent resolution adopted by a majority of the members elected to and serving in each house, inter-transfer funds within this act for the particular department, board, commission, office, or institution.

DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE

Sec. 301. (1) Funds appropriated in part 1 for enforcement of the move over law must be used by the office of highway safety planning in the department of state police for targeted enforcement of section 653a of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.653a. The office of highway safety planning in the department of state police may also use funds appropriated in part 1 for enforcement of the move over law for advertising expenses associated with making the public aware of the requirements of section 653a of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.653a.

(2) The unexpended funds appropriated in part 1 for enforcement of the move over law are designated as a work project

- appropriation. Any unencumbered or unallotted funds shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year and shall be available for expenditures for projects under this section until the projects have been completed. The following is in compliance with section 451a of the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1451a:
 - (a) The purpose of the project is to enforce and make the public aware of section 653a of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.653a.
 - (b) The project will be accomplished by utilizing state employees, contracts with service providers, or both.
 - (c) The total estimated cost of the project is \$2,000,000.00.
 - (d) The tentative completion date is September 30, 2028.
 - (3) Funds appropriated in part 1 for the enforcement of the move over law must not be spent or otherwise distributed unless Senate Bill No. 779 of the 102nd Legislature is enacted into law.

STATE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT

- Sec. 401. (1) Funds appropriated in part 1 for signage regarding the move over law must be used by the state transportation department, in consultation with the office of highway safety planning in the department of state police, to put up road signs that contain information regarding the requirements of section 653a of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.653a.
- (2) The unexpended funds appropriated in part 1 for signage regarding the move over law are designated as a work project appropriation. Any unencumbered or unallotted funds shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year and shall be available for

expenditures for projects under this section until the projects have been completed. The following is in compliance with section 451a of the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1451a:

- (a) The purpose of the project is to put up road signs that contain information regarding the requirements of section 653a of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.653a.
- (b) The project will be accomplished by utilizing state employees, contracts with service providers, or both.
 - (c) The total estimated cost of the project is \$250,000.00.
 - (d) The tentative completion date is September 30, 2028.
- (3) Funds appropriated in part 1 for signage regarding the move over law must not be spent or otherwise distributed unless Senate Bill No. 779 of the 102nd Legislature is enacted into law.
