## **SENATE BILL NO. 788**

March 13, 2024, Introduced by Senators SANTANA, BAYER, WOJNO, SHINK, POLEHANKI, GEISS, KLINEFELT, CHANG and LINDSEY and referred to the Committee on Veterans and Emergency Services.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 803t.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 803t. (1) A woman who meets either of the following
- 2 requirements may apply to the secretary of state for a special
- 3 registration plate that displays an appropriate vignette preceding
- 4 the registration numbers and has the words "woman veteran"
- 5 inscribed beneath the registration numbers:
- 6 (a) Was a member of the Michigan National Guard, the United

- 1 States Armed Forces Reserve, or any branch of the United States
- 2 Armed Forces and was called to active duty during a declared war or
- 3 an armed conflict in which the United States was a participant.
- 4 (b) Was a member of any branch of the United States Armed
- 5 Forces, including reservists and National Guard, and has retired or
- 6 been granted an honorable discharge from that branch of the United
- 7 States Armed Forces.
- 8 (2) Application for a special registration plate must be on a
- 9 form prescribed by the secretary of state and must be accompanied
- 10 by any proof of the applicant meeting the requirements of
- 11 subsection (1) that the secretary of state may require. The
- 12 application for a special registration plate must not require a
- 13 service fee under section 804.
- 14 (3) Upon proper application, the secretary of state shall
- 15 issue 1 or more special registration plates for each applicant for
- 16 use on a passenger vehicle. An individual who is disabled who
- 17 applies for a special registration plate under this section must be
- 18 issued a tab for persons with disabilities as provided in section
- 19 803f for the special registration plate. The secretary of state
- 20 shall require the same proof that the applicant is a disabled
- 21 person as is required for issuing a permanent windshield placard
- 22 under section 675. A person issued 1 or more special registration
- 23 plates under subsection (1) must be assessed the applicable tax
- 24 provided in section 801.
- 25 (4) The use of a special registration plate on a vehicle other
- 26 than the vehicle for which the plate is issued, or by a person who
- 27 does not qualify under this section, is a misdemeanor.
- 28 (5) The special registration plate issued under this section
- 29 expires on the birthday of the vehicle owner. The applicant is not

- 1 required to furnish the proof provided in subsection (2) for an
- 2 application for renewal of the special registration plate.
- 3 (6) This section does not preclude a person from applying for
- 4 any other registration plate under this act.
