## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 234d. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) or (3), a
- 2 person shall not possess a firearm on the premises of any of the
- 3 following:
- 4 (a) A depository financial institution or a subsidiary or
- 5 affiliate of a depository financial institution.
- 6 (b) A church or other house of religious worship.
- 7 (c) A court.
