## **SENATE BILL NO. 942**

June 26, 2024, Introduced by Senators POLEHANKI, MCMORROW, KLINEFELT, CHANG, BAYER, IRWIN, GEISS, WOJNO, MOSS and SHINK and referred to the Committee on Civil Rights, Judiciary, and Public Safety.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 224 (MCL 750.224), as amended by 2006 PA 401.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 224. (1) A person shall not manufacture, sell, offer for sale, or possess any of the following:
- ${f 3}$  (a) A machine gun or firearm that shoots or is designed to
- 4 shoot automatically more than 1 shot without manual reloading, by a
- 5 single function of the trigger.
- 6 (b) A muffler or silencer.

- 1 (c) A bomb or bombshell.
- 2 (d) A blackjack, slungshot, billy, metallic knuckles, sand
- 3 club, sand bag, or bludgeon.
- 4 (e) A device, weapon, cartridge, container, or contrivance
- 5 designed to render a person temporarily or permanently disabled by
- 6 the ejection, release, or emission of a gas or other substance.
- 7 (f) A bump stock.
- 8 (2) A person who violates subsection (1) is guilty of a
- 9 felony, punishable by imprisonment for not more than 5 years, or a
- 10 fine of not more than \$2,500.00, or both.
- 11 (3) Subsection (1) does not apply to any of the following:
- 12 (a) A self-defense spray or foam device as defined in section
- **13** 224d.
- 14 (b) A person manufacturing firearms, explosives, or munitions
- 15 of war by virtue of a contract with a department of the government
- 16 of the United States.
- 17 (c) A person licensed by the secretary Secretary of the
- 18 treasury Treasury of the United States or the secretary's
- 19 Secretary's delegate to manufacture, sell, or possess a machine
- 20 gun, or a device, weapon, cartridge, container, or contrivance

- 22 (4) As used in this chapter: , "muffler"
- (a) "Muffler" or "silencer" means 1 or more of the following:
- 24 (i)  $\frac{1}{2}$  A device for muffling, silencing, or deadening the
- 25 report of a firearm.
- 26 (ii) (b)—A combination of parts, designed or redesigned, and
- 27 intended for use in assembling or fabricating a muffler or
- 28 silencer.
- 29 (iii) (e)—A part, designed or redesigned, and intended only for

- 1 use in assembling or fabricating a muffler or silencer.
- 2 (b) "Bump stock" means a device that allows a semiautomatic
- 3 firearm to shoot more than 1 shot with a single pull of the trigger
- 4 by harnessing the recoil energy of the semiautomatic firearm to
- 5 which the device is affixed so that the trigger resets and
- 6 continues firing without additional physical manipulation of the
- 7 trigger by the shooter.
