## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 3406jj. Beginning January 1, 2026, an insurer that
- 2 delivers, issues for delivery, or renews in this state a health
- 3 insurance policy shall provide coverage, including point-of-sale at
- 4 an in-network pharmacy, for contraception and emergency
- 5 contraception, including over-the-counter contraception and

- emergency contraception. An insurer shall provide coverage under this section regardless of whether the contraception or emergency contraception is a prescription. As used in this section:
- 4 (a) "Contraception" means a drug, device, or other product,
  5 including, but not limited to, a hormonal drug, whether
  6 administered orally, transdermally, or intravaginally, that is
  7 approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration to
  8 prevent pregnancy.
- 9 (b) "Emergency contraception" means a drug approved by the
  10 United States Food and Drug Administration to prevent pregnancy
  11 following unprotected sexual intercourse or a known or suspected
  12 contraceptive failure.
