A bill to create a certain fund for the provision of funds to licensed adult day-care facilities; and to provide for the powers and duties of certain state and local governmental officers and entities.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act may be cited as the "licensed adult day-care
- 2 fund act".
- 3 Sec. 3. (1) The licensed adult day-care fund is created in the
- 4 state treasury.
- 5 (2) The state treasurer shall deposit money and other assets
- 6 received from any source in the fund. The state treasurer shall

- 1 direct the investment of money in the fund and credit interest and
 2 earnings from the investments to the fund. Money in the fund at the
 3 close of the fiscal year does not lapse to the general fund.
- 4 (3) The department of treasury is the administrator of the fund for audits of the fund.
- 6 (4) The department of treasury shall expend money from the 7 fund on appropriation only to provide funds to licensed adult day-8 care facilities licensed under the adult day-care facility 9 licensing act for use by those facilities on administrative and 10 operation costs.
- (5) As used in this section, "fund" means the licensed adultday-care fund created under subsection (1).
