October 08, 2024, Introduced by Senator WEBBER and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1979 PA 94, entitled "The state school aid act of 1979,"

by amending section 11 (MCL 388.1611), as amended by 2024 PA 120, and by adding section 97h.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 11. (1) For the fiscal year ending September 30, 2024,
- 2 there is appropriated for the public schools of this state and
- 3 certain other state purposes relating to education the sum of

- 14 Sec. 97h. (1) From the general fund money appropriated in
- 15 section 11, \$6,700,000.00 is allocated for 2024-2025 to public
- 16 schools and nonpublic schools for the implementation of a mobile
- 17 panic alert system in each school as required under section 1308c
- 18 of the revised school code, MCL 380.1308c.
- 19 (2) The funds allocated under this section for 2024-2025 are a
- 20 work project appropriation, and any unexpended funds for 2024-2025
- 21 are carried forward into 2025-2026. The purpose of the work project
- 22 is to implement mobile panic alert systems in public schools and
- 23 nonpublic schools. The estimated completion date of the work
- 24 project is September 30, 2027.
- 25 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 26 unless Senate Bill No. 1032 of the 102nd Legislature is enacted
- 27 into law.
