- 2 Sec. 46. (1) No Except as otherwise provided in this section, 3 no law shall be enacted providing for the penalty of death.
  - (2) The legislature may enact a law that provides for the penalty of death for a sexual crime committed against a victim who is less than 18 years of age.

  submitted to the people of the state at the next general election
  in the manner provided by law.
