AN ACT to amend 2001 PA 142, entitled "An act to consolidate prior acts naming certain Michigan highways; to provide for the naming of certain highways; to prescribe certain duties of the state transportation department; and to repeal acts and parts of acts and certain resolutions," by amending section 92 (MCL 250.1092), as added by 2006 PA 2.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Sec. 92. (1) The portion of highway US-24 in Wayne County shall be known as the "10th Mountain Division Memorial Highway".

(2) The portion of highway M-3 in Macomb County beginning at the intersection of M-3 and Harrington Boulevard and continuing north to its end shall be known as the "Ronald W. Reagan Memorial Highway".
