1           A resolution to declare May 8-12, 2023, as Teacher  
2 Appreciation Week in the state of Michigan.

3           Whereas, A strong, effective system of free public school  
4 education for all children and youth is essential to our democratic  
5 system of government; and

6           Whereas, From the early days of our democracy, the United  
7 States of America and the state of Michigan have made considerable  
8 progress in the social, technological, and scientific fields due to  
9 our system of free and universal public education; and

1           Whereas, Much of this progress can be attributed to the  
2 qualified and dedicated teachers entrusted with the educational  
3 development of our children; and

4           Whereas, Teachers should be accorded high esteem, reflecting  
5 the value our community places on public education; and

6           Whereas, The importance and impact of teachers on children is  
7 known nationwide; and

8           Whereas, It is appropriate that teachers be recognized for  
9 their dedication and commitment to educating their students; now,  
10 therefore, be it
