Whereas, Since migrating to the United States, men and women 1 of Arab descent have shared their rich culture and traditions with 2 neighbors and friends, while also setting fine examples of model 3 citizens and public servants; and 4 5 Whereas, The economic capabilities and political involvement 6 in all levels of government are a testament to the power of the 7 Arab-American community; and 8 Whereas, Arab migrants bring their resilient family values, 9 strong work ethic, dedication to education, and diversity in faith 10 and creed that add strength to our great democracy; and 11 Whereas, The vast contributions of the Arab-American community in academia, business, medicine, science, and social justice 12 continue to make our state a better place to live; and 13 14 Whereas, The working class population of this community has 15 played a pivotal role in the establishment of industrial force that our state is known for today; and 16 Whereas, Arab-Americans join all Americans in the desire for a 17 18 peaceful and diverse society where every individual is treated
