Senators Irwin, Brinks, Geiss, Moss and Singh offered the following resolution:

- 2 and April 23-29, 2023, as Reentry Week.
- 3 Whereas, Every human being is worthy of respect and dignity;
- 4 and
- 5 Whereas, Redemption and rehabilitation are core to our beliefs
- 6 and commitment to one another; and
- 7 Whereas, Second chances and opportunities to rebuild one's
- 8 life after an arrest or incarceration are pivotal to not only
- 9 individuals, but also to strong and healthy communities in
- 10 Michigan; and
- 11 Whereas, More than 4 million Michiganders have some type of

- 1 arrest or conviction history; and
- 2 Whereas, People with conviction histories face immense
- 3 barriers when returning to our communities, such as challenges to
- 4 obtaining safe and stable housing, finding employment, accessing
- 5 education, reuniting with family, and navigating restrictions on
- 6 their mobility; and
- 7 Whereas, The barriers faced by people with conviction
- 8 histories are disproportionately felt by people of color and people
- 9 experiencing poverty; and
- 10 Whereas, People who are formerly incarcerated are almost 10
- 11 times more likely than the general public to be unhoused; and
- 12 Whereas, Removing barriers and increasing access to stable
- 13 housing and meaningful employment is linked to decreased crime and
- 14 improved public safety; and
- 15 Whereas, Michigan has made great strides with historic Clean
- 16 Slate legislation to expunge Michiganders' records, breaking down
- 17 barriers to housing, employment, and other essential needs; and
- 18 Whereas, Continued efforts must be made to ensure that all
- 19 Michiganders have access to second chances and opportunities to
- 20 build a healthy life for our collective communities to be whole and
- 21 strong; now, therefore, be it
- 22 Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative
- 23 body recognize April 2023 as Second Chance Month and April 23-29,
- 24 2023, as Reentry Week. We recognize the importance of second
- 25 chances and removing barriers for people with conviction histories.
