- 11 worldwide organizations, including Burn Survivors Of Michigan, to

- 1 provide a source of hope, sense of community, and continued
- 2 advocacy to improve lives around the world; now, therefore, be it
- 3 Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative
- 4 body designate September 27, 2023, as Face Equality Day; and be it
- 5 further
- 6 Resolved, That we urge residents to take part in raising
- 7 awareness and support for those with facial disfigurements.
