1 A resolution to recognize March 3-9, 2024, as School Social

2 Work Week.

3 Whereas, School social workers serve as vital members of the

4 education team, playing a central role in creating a positive

5 environment in schools; and

6 Whereas, Social workers in schools are exceptionally skilled

7 in providing services to students who face serious challenges to

8 school success including disability, poverty, discrimination,

9 abuse, neglect, mental illness, homelessness, bullying, familial

10 stressors, and other barriers to learning; and

11 Whereas, School-based mental health programs are critical to

- 1 the early identification and intervention of mental health problems
- 2 by providing the appropriate services; and
- 3 Whereas, School social workers, who are licensed mental health
- 4 professionals in the United States, provide the necessary
- 5 assessment, interventions, counseling, family outreach, community
- 6 referrals, and also maintain knowledge of school culture and
- 7 climate, which are all necessary for responsible school safety
- 8 planning; and
- 9 Whereas, Research indicates that school-based mental health
- 10 programs led by school social workers improve educational outcomes
- 11 by decreasing absences, dropout rates, and discipline referrals,
- 12 while also improving academic achievement; and
- 13 Whereas, Social workers in schools play a pivotal role in
- 14 creating partnerships between the home, school, and community to
- 15 ensure academic success; and
- 16 Whereas, School districts and local educational agencies
- 17 should continue to work with school social workers to address
- 18 students' social, emotional, physical, mental health, and
- 19 environmental needs so that students can succeed; and
- 20 Whereas, The celebration of School Social Work Week on March
- 21 3-9, 2024, highlights the important role school social workers play
- 22 in the lives of students in Michigan; now, therefore, be it
- 23 Resolved, That the members of this legislative body recognize
- 24 March 3-9, 2024, as School Social Work Week; and be it further
- 25 Resolved, That we honor and recognize the contributions of
- 26 school social workers to the successes of students; and be it
