3 Whereas, More than 2,500 Michigan residents are currently

4 waiting for a lifesaving organ transplant and thousands more would

5 benefit from tissue and corneal transplants; and

6 Whereas, Michigan has about 4.6 million people on the Organ

Donor Registry, but more than 42 percent of adults have not yet

8 registered to save and heal others; and

9 Whereas, The need for organ, tissue, and eye donations remains

10 a critical need in both Michigan and the United States; and

11 Whereas, Nationwide, an average of 20 people die each day

- 1 because a donated organ did not become available; and
- 2 Whereas, Organ, tissue, and eye donation can provide families
- 3 that are tragically confronted by the death of a loved one the
- 4 comfort of knowing that the gift of life provides another person
- 5 with renewed hope for a healthy life; and
- 6 Whereas, A single organ, tissue, and eye donation can save
- 7 eight lives and improve the lives of up to 75 people; and
- 8 Whereas, The act of giving the gift of life through organ,
- 9 tissue, and eye donation to someone facing imminent death, or
- 10 living with blindness or a disability, is the ultimate act of
- 11 generosity and kindness; now, therefore, be it
- 12 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 13 this legislative body declare February 14, 2023, as National Donor
- 14 Day in the state of Michigan; and be it further
- 15 Resolved, That we encourage all residents to join the Michigan
- 16 Organ Donor Registry, share their decision with their families,
- 17 friends, and colleagues, and encourage them to do the same.
