## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.159

Rep. VanWoerkom offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to declare November 2023 as Diabetes Awareness 2 Month in the state of Michigan. 3 Whereas, Approximately 965,000 adults and children in Michigan are affected by Type 1 or Type 2 diabetes and approximately 37.3 4 million Americans are affected nationwide; and 6 Whereas, Approximately 63,200 new people are diagnosed with 7 diabetes each year in Michigan; and 8 Whereas, Type 1 diabetes typically presents during childhood 9 or adolescence, but can also develop in adults; and Whereas, The warning signs of Type 1 diabetes include 10 excessive thirst, frequent urination, rapid weight loss, stomach 11 pain, nausea, vomiting, fatigue, and weakness, and are often 12 mistaken for the flu, strep throat, a growth spurt, or a urinary 13

- 1 tract infection; and
- Whereas, In 2019, approximately 283,000 children and
- 3 adolescents younger than 20 years old had diagnosed diabetes in the
- 4 United States; and
- 5 Whereas, The warning signs of Type 2 diabetes include
- 6 increased thirst, frequent urination, increased appetite, weight
- 7 loss, fatigue, and dark patches of skin; and
- 8 Whereas, As childhood obesity increases, there is an ongoing
- 9 shift of Type 2 Diabetes from an adult disease to one that affects
- 10 children; and
- 11 Whereas, The 2022 direct medical cost of diabetes in Michigan
- 12 was estimated at \$7 billion; and
- 13 Whereas, There is not a cure for Types 1 or 2 diabetes, but
- 14 the diseases may be manageable through diet, exercise, insulin
- 15 therapy or other medications; now, therefore, be it
- 16 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 17 this legislative body declare November 2023 as Diabetes Awareness
- 18 Month in the state of Michigan.
