## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.173

The Speaker, on behalf of the entire membership of the House of Representatives, offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution of tribute for Clark E. Bisbee, former member of 2 the Michigan House of Representatives.
- 3 Whereas, It is with great sadness that the members of this
- 4 legislative body learned about the passing of Clark Bisbee. He will
- 5 be remembered as a dedicated public servant and leader who loyally
- 6 served his constituents in the greater Jackson area in the Sixty-
- 7 Fourth District; and
- 8 Whereas, Clark Bisbee was born in Jackson to Leland S. Bisbee,
- 9 Jr. and Margaret Clark Bisbee. After receiving his bachelor's
- 10 degree in business from Albion College, he began his storied career
- 11 with City Bank & Trust and spent ten years managing the bank's
- 12 operations in mid-Michigan. In 1978, Mr. Bisbee founded Bisbee

- 1 Infrared Services, which provided the mid-Michigan region with
- 2 thermographic imaging services for decades. Always the family man,

- 3 Mr. Bisbee then stepped up to lead Lee Bisbee Travel Service Inc.,
- 4 the travel agency founded by his father. Under his leadership, the
- 5 family business became the premier travel agency in Michigan. Lee
- 6 Bisbee Travel Service Inc. had over 40 employees in five offices
- 7 across the state at its peak and served the community for over 50
- 8 years before closing its doors in 2009. While at the helm of Lee
- 9 Bisbee Travel Service Inc., Mr. Bisbee also served as the president
- 10 of the American Society of Travel Agents; and
- 11 Whereas, Clark Bisbee was a pillar of his community. His
- 12 family business sponsored local little league teams for decades,
- 13 while he served as a member of the Greater Jackson Chamber of
- 14 Commerce; the YMCA Expansion Committee; Queen's Parish
- 15 Administration Council; Father Coyle Society; Lutheran School PTO;
- 16 Jackson Rotary; and countless other organizations. Mr. Bisbee's
- 17 attitude of genuine friendship and positivity towards everybody
- 18 served him well in his various positions throughout the community;

- 20 Whereas, Clark Bisbee was first elected to the Michigan House
- 21 of Representatives in 1998 and served until 2004. During his
- 22 tenure, he chaired the Joint Select Committee on Business
- 23 Competitiveness, the Commerce Committee, and the Training and
- 24 Safety Committee; was the vice chair for the Insurance and
- 25 Financial Services Committee for two terms; and was a member of the
- 26 committees on Economic Development, Energy and Technology, Great
- 27 Lakes and Tourism, Employment Relations, Insurance, and Regulatory
- 28 Reform. While in office, Mr. Bisbee was an effective representative
- 29 who worked across the aisle with now United States Senator Gary

- 1 Peters to spearhead an amendment to Michigan's Constitution to
- 2 require a majority of the members in Michigan's House of
- 3 Representatives and Senate to approve a salary increase for the
- 4 following term; and
- 5 Whereas, Clark Bisbee is survived by his wife, Kathleen
- 6 "Katie" Miller Bisbee of over 39 years; four children, Casey,
- 7 Megan, Leland IV, and Peter; seven grandchildren; and his siblings,
- 8 Leland III, Margaret, and Constance. His parents and sister,
- 9 Patrice, preceded him in death. His family described him as a
- 10 devoted and adoring husband, father, grandfather, brother, and
- 11 uncle whose calmness and relentless positivity endeared him to
- 12 anyone with whom he crossed paths. Described by those who worked
- 13 close to him as a model for citizen legislators, Mr. Bisbee always
- 14 prioritized his family and was home with his family every night. He
- 15 will be greatly missed and fondly remembered; now, therefore, be it

- 17 resolution of tribute for Clark E. Bisbee, former member of the
