HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 188

Reps. DeSana, Fox, Jaime Greene, Smit, Beeler, Carra, Friske, Zorn, Fink and Meerman offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to call for the immediate release of Jimmy Lai
- 2 from imprisonment and urge the United States government to assert
- 3 diplomatic pressure on the governments of the People's Republic of
- 4 China and the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region to help
- 5 secure Mr. Lai's release.
- 6 Whereas, Jimmy Lai is a longtime advocate for freedom and
- 7 democracy in Hong Kong. Although Mr. Lai has British citizenship,
- 8 he chose to live in Hong Kong and pursue a career in media,
- 9 founding the newspaper Apple Daily in 1995, just a few years after
- 10 the Tiananmen Square protests and shortly before Hong Kong was
- 11 transferred from the United Kingdom to the People's Republic of
- 12 China. Apple Daily became a well-known, successful publication,

- 1 investigating local corruption and speaking out against overreach
- 2 by the Chinese Communist Party. In 2019, when Hong Kong was swept
- 3 by a wave of pro-democracy, anti-government protests, Apple Daily
- 4 was a strong and outspoken supporter of the movement, printing
- 5 posters for the demonstrators. Mr. Lai established himself as a
- 6 high-profile, staunch supporter of the rights promised to Hong Kong
- 7 under the terms of the Sino-British Joint Declaration on the
- 8 Question of Hong Kong in 1984; and
- 9 Whereas, In 2020, the Chinese government retaliated against
- 10 Mr. Lai and Apple Daily, arresting Mr. Lai and charging him with
- 11 collusion with a foreign country, a crime established by a new
- 12 national security law that China unilaterally imposed on Hong Kong.
- 13 Having been delayed multiple times, Mr. Lai's trial under the
- 14 national security law is currently set for December 2023, and he
- 15 could face a life sentence if convicted. In 2021, Apple Daily was
- 16 forced to close after the Chinese government raided the newsroom,
- 17 seized the company's computers, froze its assets, and arrested
- 18 multiple company executives and a journalist. While awaiting trial
- 19 under the national security law, Mr. Lai has also been convicted of
- 20 fraud for violating the terms of a lease, on charges the United
- 21 States Department of State called "spurious," for which he was
- 22 sentenced to five years and nine months' imprisonment; charged with
- 23 conspiracy to print seditious publications; and convicted for two
- 24 instances of "unauthorized assembly" for his participation in a
- 25 pro-democracy rally in 2019 and a Tiananmen Square vigil in 2020,
- 26 for which he was sentenced to over two years in prison; and
- Whereas, It is unacceptable for the People's Republic of China
- 28 and the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region to weaponize their
- 29 national security law for purposes of political repression, as they

- 1 have done in the case of Mr. Lai. The United States and the United
- 2 Nations Human Rights Committee have expressed deep concern about
- 3 the national security law and its implementation, and the European
- 4 Parliament recently adopted a resolution urging the release of Mr.
- 5 Lai and other pro-democracy activists who were imprisoned for
- 6 exercising the freedom of speech and expression. Democracies around
- 7 the world are recognizing the blatant disregard and disrespect for
- 8 fundamental human freedoms in Hong Kong in recent years; and
- 9 Whereas, China's 2020 national security law and its
- 10 utilization for political purposes pose a threat to free speech
- 11 around the globe, including in Michigan. The national security law
- 12 purports to apply to violations committed outside of Hong Kong by
- 13 non-residents, a feature the United Nations Human Rights Committee
- 14 has noted with grave concern. Michiganders should not have to fear
- 15 being treated like Mr. Lai if they exercise their rights under the
- 16 United States Constitution to engage in political speech; now,
- 17 therefore, be it
- 18 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That we call for the
- 19 immediate release of Jimmy Lai from imprisonment; and be it further
- 20 Resolved, That we urge the United States government to assert
- 21 diplomatic pressure on the governments of the People's Republic of
- 22 China and the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region to help
- 23 secure Mr. Lai's release; and be it further
- 24 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
- 25 United States Secretary of State and the United States Ambassador
- 26 to the People's Republic of China.
