HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.191

Rep. Hoskins offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to denounce the espousal of racist, xenophobic,
- ${f 2}$ and white supremacist language by members of this chamber.
- 3 Whereas, The Michigan House of Representatives is known as
- 4 "the people's house." It is the legislative chamber that is closest
- 5 to the people of this state, and the members elected to and serving
- 6 therein are the voice of those people; and
- 7 Whereas, The state of Michigan is a beautifully diverse state.
- 8 Michigan and its people are so vibrant because of, not in spite of,
- 9 the different identities, backgrounds, and cultures of the people
- 10 who call our state home; and
- 11 Whereas, The promotion and espousal of racist, xenophobic, and
- 12 white supremacist language, regardless of the source or form, is a
- 13 vile stain on our society. Such language and images often draw on

- 1 stereotypes and conspiracy theories that do not reflect the reality
- 2 of the world or its people. Such discourse has been used to incite
- 3 and justify deadly violence against individuals and communities of
- 4 color; and
- 5 Whereas, We rightly hold elected officials to a higher
- 6 standard in matters of discourse. The language of leadership
- 7 carries a greater weight with the general public than that coming
- 8 from peers. When a person in a position of authority spreads words
- 9 and images designed to foment hate and division, it sends a signal
- 10 that those words and images are acceptable for use in the
- 11 marketplace of ideas; now, therefore, be it
- 12 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That we denounce the
- 13 espousal of racist, xenophobic, and white supremacist language,
- 14 theories, and images, as they do not belong in societal discourse
- 15 and serve only to stoke fear, hatred, and division, ideas
- 16 antithetical to the functioning of "the people's house"; and be it

- 18 Resolved, That such language, theories, and images being
- 19 posted, reposted, or otherwise shared by members of the Michigan
- 20 House of Representatives represents a failure of decorum and a
- 21 dereliction of each member's duty both as the voice of a diverse
- 22 group of people and as a keeper of the public trust; and be it
- 23 further
- 24 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
- 25 every member of the Michigan House of Representatives.
