- 7 this legislative body declare September 29-October 5, 2024, as
- 8 Homeschool Week in the state of Michigan. We recognize the hard
- 9 work, dedication, and commitment of home educator parents and
- 10 quardians in providing quality education to their children and
- 11 acknowledge the right of parents and guardians as outlined in the
- 12 Michigan Constitution to choose homeschooling as a legitimate
- 13 educational alternative and emphasizes the importance of respecting
- 14 the diversity of educational choices available to Michigan
- 15 families; and be it further
- 16 Resolved, That Homeschool Week aims to promote and celebrate
- 17 the benefits of homeschooling as a viable educational option for
- 18 families in Michigan. We commend homeschooling parents and
- 19 guardians for their dedication to their children's education and
- 20 for contributing positively to the overall educational fabric of
- 21 our state.
