## SENATE RESOLUTION NO.26

Senators Bumstead, Damoose, Hauck, Hoitenga, Outman, Huizenga, Lauwers, Cherry and McBroom offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution to commemorate the 50th anniversary of the

2 National Wild Turkey Federation (NWTF).

3 Whereas, The National Wild Turkey Federation was incorporated

on March 28, 1973 in Fredericksburg, Virginia; and

5 Whereas, Over the course of 50 years, the NWTF and millions of

6 members and chapters across the nation have worked with state,

7 federal, and nongovernmental partners to promote the conservation

of the wild turkey and the preservation of our hunting heritage,

participating in one of the greatest conservation success stories

10 in American history — the return of the wild turkey from the brink

11 of extinction; and

Whereas, The NWTF and its Michigan State Chapter helped the 1 2 Michigan Department of Natural Resources restore wild turkey populations across the state, resulting in an estimated 200,000 3 birds, which supports robust and healthy wild turkey populations 4 5 capable of hunting opportunities in all 83 counties in our state; 6 and 7 Whereas, The NWTF, its members, and chapters have been at the 8 vanguard of reversing the decline in hunting participation through 9 nationwide investment in hunter recruitment, retention, and 10 reactivation efforts. They also partner with other states to 11 develop opportunities to engage people from all walks of life in the outdoors tradition. Since 2012, the NWTF has recruited and 12 reactivated more than 1.5 million hunters, including Michigan which 13 14 was one of the first states to develop a NWTF cooperatively-funded 15 position focused on addressing hunter participation; and 16 Whereas, Since 1985, the NWTF has invested more than half a 17 billion dollars to conserve or enhance more than 22 million acres 18 of critical wildlife habitat, forests, and grasslands across public 19 and private lands. This work includes Michigan's state and national 20 forests, publicly owned and managed wildlife areas, as well as 21 private lands; and 22 Whereas, The NWTF is also the largest and longest-serving 23 nongovernmental stewardship partner of the United States Department of Agriculture Forest Service, conserving habitat on National 24 25 Forest System lands for more than 40 years. Since 2012, the NWTF 26 has helped support and facilitate work on each of the national 27 forests located in Michigan; and Whereas, The NWTF, its members, and chapters have invested 28

more than \$8.5 million in research throughout North America to
