House Bill 4328 contains supplemental appropriation adjustments for the Department of State Police. Appropriation adjustments total \$75.0 million Gross, \$75.0 million GF/GP.

**STATE POLICE**

***1. Storm Disaster Relief Grants***

Includes \$75.0 million GF/GP for storm disaster relief grants. Funding would be allocated by the Department of State Police to local units to assist with identifying and securing disaster assistance for individual residents, businesses, and communities that have realized a significant financial hardship caused by recent storm damage.

**FY 2024-25 Supplemental Boilerplate Items**

**GENERAL SECTIONS**

***Sec. 201. State Spending and State Appropriations Paid to Local Units of Government***

Lists amount of state spending from state sources included in the bill and amount of state spending to be paid to local units of government.

***Sec. 202. Appropriations Subject to Management and Budget Act***

Subjects appropriations to the Management and Budget Act, 1984 PA 431.

***Sec. 203. State Administrative Board Transfers***

Authorizes the legislature, by a concurrent resolution adopted by a majority of members elected to and serving in each house, to inter-transfer funds if State Administrative Board transfers funds.

**STATE POLICE**

***Sec. 301. Storm Disaster Relief Grants***

Requires funding to be allocated by the department to local units to be used to assist individual residents, businesses, and communities with disaster assistance efforts. Lists purposes for which funding can be used including, but not limited to, state match funding required for receipt and expenditure of federal funding made available; emergency actions needed to protect life, property, public health, and public safety; labor assistance including unemployment benefits, temporary employment opportunities, and support for dislocated workers; energy assistance to prevent shutoffs; and repair or replacement of disaster-damaged infrastructure. Requires any remaining funds to be allocated for addressing damage on land owned by the state and DNR, and to reimburse other third-party providers that assisted in disaster recovery efforts. Designates unexpended funding as a work project appropriation.
