SUMMARY:

House Bill 4745 would amend the Charitable Organizations and Solicitations Act to exempt certain nonprofit corporations from the act's registration and reporting requirements for charitable organizations.

Currently, the act provides that its registration and reporting requirements do not apply to certain listed entities.

The bill would add nonprofit corporations that are primarily engaged in the collection, storage, transportation, and distribution of donated food items to the list of exempt entities.
