CONTENT

The bill would amend the Michigan Memorial Highway Act to designate the portion of Highway M-50 in Monroe County beginning at the intersection with South Raisinville Road and extending east to the intersection with Herr Road as the "Animal Control Officer Darrian Young Memorial Highway".

Proposed MCL 250.1006d

BRIEF RATIONALE

Darrian Young was born in Monroe, Michigan on April 29, 1996. She was employed as a Monroe County Animal Control Officer at the Monroe County Sheriff's Office for one year. Around 8 AM on June 4, 2020, Animal Control Officer Young was driving an Animal Control Division vehicle and was struck by a drunk driver going 80 miles per hour at an intersection. Animal Control Officer Young died as a result of the crash. The bill should be passed to honor her service and make sure she is not forgotten.

PREVIOUS LEGISLATION

(This section does not provide a comprehensive account of previous legislative efforts on this subject matter.)

Senate Bill 69 is a reintroduction of Senate Bill 978 from the 2023-2024 Legislative Session. Senate Bill 978 passed the Senate and was referred to the House Committee on Transportation, Mobility and Infrastructure but received no further action.
