MICHIGAN NATURAL RESOURCES TRUST FUND

- Sec. 301. (1) The department of natural resources shall enter into agreements with local units of government to administer the grants identified in part 1. Among other provisions, the agreements must require that grant recipients do all of the following:
- (a) Dedicate to public outdoor recreation uses in perpetuity the land acquired or developed.
 - (b) Replace lands converted or lost to other than public outdoor recreation use.
- (c) For parcels acquired that are larger than 5 acres, provide this state with a nonparticipating 1/6 minimum royalty interest in any acquired minerals that are retained by the grant recipient.
- 18 (2) The agreements under subsection (1) must also provide that
 19 the full payments of grants be made only after proof of
 20 acquisition, or proof of completion of a development project, is
 21 submitted by the grant recipient and all costs are verified by the
 22 department of natural resources. This requirement may be waived by
 23 the department of natural resources.
