THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 109q. The department shall provide coverage under the medical assistance program for ultrasound procedures and fetal nonstress tests performed remotely in a residence or other off-site location through telemedicine.
- 5 Sec. 109r. (1) The department shall amend its rules for fee-

- (2) Remote ultrasounds are reimbursable only when the provider uses digital technology as follows:
- 9 (a) To collect medical and other forms of health data from a
 10 patient and electronically transmit that data securely to a health
 11 care provider in a different location for interpretation and
 - (b) That meets both of the following conditions:
- 14 (i) Is compliant with the health insurance portability and accountability act of 1996, Public Law 104-191.
- 16 (ii) Is approved by the United States Food and Drug
 17 Administration.
- 18 (3) Remote fetal nonstress tests are reimbursable only when 19 all of the following conditions are met:
- 20 (a) The requirements of subsection (2) (a) and (b) are met.
- 21 **(b)** They have a place of service modifier for at-home
 22 monitoring with remote monitoring solutions that are cleared by the
 23 United States Food and Drug Administration for on-label use for
 24 monitoring fetal heart rate, maternal heart rate, or uterine
 25 activity.
- 26 **(4)** The department shall adopt and publish guidelines to 27 implement this section and section 109q.
