## SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 224

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 224 (MCL 750.224), as amended by 2006 PA 401.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 224. (1) A person shall not manufacture, sell, offer for 2 sale, or possess any of the following:
- 3 (a) A machine gun or firearm that shoots or is designed to
- 4 shoot automatically more than 1 shot without manual reloading, by a
- 5 single function of the trigger.
- 6 (b) A muffler or silencer.
- 7 (c) A bomb or bombshell.
- 8 (d) A blackjack, slungshot, billy, metallic knuckles, sand
- 9 club, sand bag, or bludgeon.

- 1 (e) A device, weapon, cartridge, container, or contrivance 2 designed to render a person temporarily or permanently disabled by 3 the ejection, release, or emission of a gas or other substance.
- 4 (f) A bump stock.

- (g) A multiburst trigger activator.
- 6 (2) A person who that violates subsection (1) is guilty of a
  7 felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than 5 years, or a
  8 fine of not more than \$2,500.00, or both.
  - (3) Subsection (1) does not apply to any of the following:
- 10 (a) A self-defense spray or foam device as defined in section 11 224d.
- 12 (b) A person manufacturing firearms, explosives, or munitions 13 of war by virtue of a contract with a department of the government 14 of the United States.
- 15 (c) A person licensed by the secretary Secretary of the
  16 treasury Treasury of the United States or the secretary's
  17 Secretary's delegate to manufacture, sell, or possess a machine
  18 gun, or a device, weapon, cartridge, container, or contrivance
  19 described in subsection (1).

- 21 (a) "Bump stock" means a device that allows a semiautomatic
  22 firearm to shoot more than 1 shot with a single pull of the trigger
  23 by harnessing the recoil energy of the semiautomatic firearm to
  24 which the device is affixed so that the trigger resets and
  25 continues firing without additional physical manipulation of the
  26 trigger by the shooter.
  - (b) "Muffler" or "silencer" means 1 or more of the following:
- 28 (i) (a)—A device for muffling, silencing, or deadening the 29 report of a firearm.

- 1 (ii) (b) A combination of parts, designed or redesigned, and
  2 intended for use in assembling or fabricating a muffler or
  3 silencer.
- 4 (iii) (c) A part, designed or redesigned, and intended only for 5 use in assembling or fabricating a muffler or silencer.
- 6 (c) "Multiburst trigger activator" means any of the following:
- 7 (i) A device designed or redesigned to be attached to, built
  8 into, or used in conjunction with a semiautomatic firearm that
  9 allows the firearm to discharge 2 or more shots in a burst by
  10 activating the device.
  - (ii) A manual or power-driven trigger activating device constructed and designed so that when attached to, built into, or used in conjunction with a semiautomatic firearm, it increases the rate of fire of that firearm.
- (iii) A device designed or redesigned to be attached to, built into, or used in conjunction with a semiautomatic firearm that enhances the firing rate of a firearm to mimic rapid or automatic fire.
- 19 (d) Multiburst trigger activator includes, but is not limited 20 to, any of the following devices:
  - (i) A device placed within the trigger guard of a firearm that uses a spring to push back against the recoil of the firearm causing the finger in the trigger guard to move back and forth and rapidly activate the trigger.
- 25 (ii) A mechanical device that activates the trigger of the 26 firearm in rapid succession by turning a crank.
- 27 (iii) Any aftermarket trigger or trigger system that, if 28 installed, allows more than 1 round to be fired with a single 29 depression of the trigger.
