A bill to prohibit members of the legislature from entering into certain nondisclosure agreements.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act may be cited as the "nondisclosure agreement act".
- 3 Sec. 2. (1) Beginning on and after the effective date of this
- 4 act, a member of the legislature shall not enter into a
- 5 nondisclosure agreement regarding any work done in that member's
- 6 legislative capacity.
- 7 (2) A nondisclosure agreement entered into in violation of

- 1 this act is void.
- 2 Sec. 3. This act applies to any nondisclosure agreement that
- 3 is entered into, amended, extended, or renewed on or after the
- 4 effective date of this act.
- 5 Enacting section 1. This act does not take effect unless
- 6 Senate Bill No. (request no. S01306'25) or House Bill No.
- 7 4053 (request no. H01306'25) of the 103rd Legislature is enacted
- 8 into law.
