A bill to amend 1967 PA 150, entitled "Michigan military act,"

(MCL 32.501 to 32.851) by adding section 203.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 203. (1) This section may be known as the "defend the guard act".
- 3 (2) Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, the
- 4 Michigan national guard and any member of the Michigan national
- 5 guard must not be released from this state into active duty combat

- 1 unless the United States Congress has passed an official
- 2 declaration of war or has taken an official action under clause 15
- 3 of section 8 of article I of the Constitution of the United States
- 4 to explicitly call forth the state militia to execute the laws of
- 5 the union, suppress an insurrection, or repel an invasion. The
- 6 governor shall take all actions necessary to comply with the
- 7 requirements of this section.
- 8 (3) As used in this section, "active duty combat" and
- 9 "official declaration of war" mean those terms as defined in
- 10 section 203a.
- 11 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 12 unless House Bill No. 4164 (request no. H01713'25) of the 103rd
- 13 Legislature is enacted into law.
