- 5 which a patient can end voluntary mental health treatment.

- 9 (i) A copy of the written consent.
- 10 (ii) Notwithstanding any other provision under this act, a copy
- 11 of the form described under section 419 even if the patient or
- 12 other individual described in section 419 does not communicate an
- 13 intention to terminate the patient's mental health treatment to a
- 14 hospital or provider of mental health treatment.
