by amending the title and sections 3 and 5 (MCL 380.1893 and 380.1895).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 TITLE

An act to provide for certain requirements regarding suicide prevention for schools; to prescribe the rights, powers, duties,
