HOUSE BILL NO. 4227

March 12, 2025, Introduced by Reps. Fairbairn, Greene, Rigas, Woolford, Kunse, Schmaltz, Schuette, Thompson, Linting and Meerman and referred to Committee on Education and Workforce.

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A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1308g.
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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1308g. The board of each intermediate school district
- 2 shall ensure that it employs at least 1 emergency and safety
- 3 manager and at least 1 mental health coordinator. All of the
- 4 following apply to the roles described in this section, as
- 5 applicable:

- 1 (a) With regard to an emergency and safety manager, all of the following:
- 3 (i) The individual must be tasked with serving as a liaison
- 4 between state agency school safety offices, the emergency
- 5 management and homeland security division within the department of
- 6 state police, emergency management and homeland security district
- 7 coordinators, local emergency management coordinators, the state
- 8 fire marshal, the school safety and mental health commission
- 9 created in section 1308h, and public schools and nonpublic schools
- 10 located within the geographic boundaries of the intermediate school
- 11 district.
- 12 (ii) The individual must be tasked with working with school
- 13 administrators, local and state emergency management coordinators,
- 14 and emergency responders to implement prevention programs related
- 15 to school safety; communicating with parents, legal guardians, and
- 16 the community about school safety; and handling all safety-related
- 17 issues concerning schools located in the geographic boundaries of
- 18 the intermediate school district.
- 19 (iii) The individual shall perform risk assessments of, and
- 20 provide response training in, the intermediate school district and
- 21 public schools and nonpublic schools located in the intermediate
- 22 school district.
- 23 (iv) The individual shall coordinate with local law enforcement
- 24 concerning any notifications received regarding tips as described
- 25 in section 2 of 2018 PA 435, MCL 28.682.
- 26 (v) Compile data to measure the outcomes and performance
- 27 related to school safety plans, school safety trainings, school
- 28 safety products, and other school safety measures in the
- 29 intermediate school district and public schools and nonpublic

- 1 schools in the geographic boundaries of the intermediate school
- 2 district.
- 3 (b) With regard to a mental health coordinator, all of the 4 following:
- 5 (i) Coordinate state funding intended to enhance and expand the 6 availability of mental health services and supports for students.
- 7 (ii) Coordinate the integration of community-based mental 8 health services in the intermediate school district and public 9 schools and nonpublic schools located in the geographic boundaries 10 of the intermediate school district and foster partnerships between 11 the intermediate school district, public schools, nonpublic
- 12 schools, and mental health providers.
- 13 (iii) Facilitate behavioral health assessment teams.
- 14 (iv) Develop and implement a comprehensive school-community 15 mental health system.
- 16 (v) Develop and curate a behavioral health community resource 17 map.
- (vi) Facilitate and support the deployment of BH-Works, the behavioral health care platform, in the intermediate school district and public schools and nonpublic schools located in the geographic boundaries of the intermediate school district.
- (vii) Compile data to measure outcomes and performance of behavioral health programs in the intermediate school district and public schools and nonpublic schools located in the geographic boundaries of the intermediate school district.
- (viii) Recruit, retain, and develop the use of behavioral health providers for or in the intermediate school district and public schools and nonpublic schools located in the geographic boundaries of the intermediate school district.

- 1 (ix) Provide training and coaching and coordinate professional 2 learning opportunities in the intermediate school district and
- 3 public schools and nonpublic schools located in the geographic
- 4 boundaries of the intermediate school district.
- 5 (x) Oversee and monitor, in compliance with other laws,
- 6 Medicaid billing and the Caring for Students (C4S) program as it
- 7 pertains to the intermediate school district and public schools and
- 8 nonpublic schools located in the geographic boundaries of the
- 9 intermediate school district.
- 10 (xi) Meet with and work with school mental health
- 11 professionals, including, but not limited to, psychologists, social
- 12 workers, doctors, nurses, and psychiatrists, to connect the
- 13 intermediate school district and public schools and nonpublic
- 14 schools located within the geographic boundaries of the
- 15 intermediate school district with child and adolescent health
- 16 centers, state departments and agencies, local governments, social
- 17 service agencies, and health care organizations to aid in the
- 18 identification of and support of students at risk for behavioral
- 19 health issues.
- 20 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 21 unless all of the following bills of the 103rd Legislature are
- 22 enacted into law.
