A bill to amend 1978 PA 390, entitled

"An act to regulate the time and manner of payment of wages and fringe benefits to employees; to prescribe rights and responsibilities of employers and employees, and the powers and duties of the department of labor; to require keeping of records; to provide for settlement of disputes regarding wages and fringe benefits; to prohibit certain practices by employers; to prescribe penalties and remedies; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

by amending section 18 (MCL 408.488).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 18. (1) The department shall order an employer who that

- 1 violates section 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, or 8 to pay **any of** the
- 2 following:
- 3 (a) Wages due to the employee.
- 4 (b) Fringe benefits due to or on the behalf of the employee in
- ${f 5}$ accordance with ${f the\ terms\ set\ forth\ in\ }$ the written contract or
- 6 written policy.
- 7 (c) A penalty at the rate of 10% 100% annually on the wages
- 8 and fringe benefits due to the employee, beginning at the time the
- 9 employer is notified that a complaint has been filed and ending
- 10 when payment is made.
- 11 (2) The department may order an employer who that violates
- 12 section 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, or 8 to pay to the employee exemplary
- 13 damages of not more than twice 3 times the amount of the wages and
- 14 fringe benefits which that were due to the employee, if the
- 15 violation is flagrant or repeated.
- 16 (3) The department may order an employer who—that violates
- 17 section 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, or 8 to pay attorney costs, hearing
- 18 costs, and transcript costs.
- 19 (4) The department may assess a civil penalty fine of not more
- 20 than \$1,000.00 \$10,000.00 against an employer who that violates
- 21 this act. , which The civil penalty shall fine must be credited to
- 22 the general fund of this state.
- 23 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 24 after the date it is enacted into law.
