A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 16608 (MCL 333.16608), as amended by 2021 PA 12.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 16608. (1) The board may issue a health profession
- 2 specialty field license to a dentist who has advanced training
- 3 beyond that required for initial licensure and who has demonstrated
- 4 competency through examination or other evaluative processes in 1

- 1 or more of the following health profession specialty fields:
- 2 (a) Prosthodontics, endodontics, oral and maxillofacial
- 3 surgery, orthodontics, pediatric dentistry, periodontics, or oral
- 4 pathology.
- 5 (b) Beginning September 1, 2022, oral medicine, orofacial
- 6 pain, dental public health, oral and maxillofacial radiology, or
- 7 dental anesthesiology.
- 8 (2) A dentist who held a health profession specialty
- 9 certification in 1 or more of the health profession specialty
- 10 fields listed in subsection (1)(a) on December 23, 2002 is
- 11 considered to hold a health profession specialty field license on
- 12 that date in each of those health profession specialty fields and
- 13 may obtain renewal of each health profession specialty field
- 14 license on the expiration date of the specialty certification.
- 15 (3) A health profession specialty field license issued under
- 16 this section must be renewed concurrently with the license to
- 17 practice dentistry.
- 18 (4) This section does not prohibit a dentist who has not been
- 19 issued a health profession specialty field license under this
- 20 section from performing services in 1 or more of the health
- 21 profession specialty fields listed in subsection (1).
- 22 (5) Beginning January 1, 2026, in addition to the prohibitions
- 23 in section 16261, a dentist who has not been issued a health
- 24 profession specialty field license under this section shall not
- 25 announce or represent to the public that the dentist is a dental
- 26 specialist or that the dentist specializes in an area under the
- 27 practice of dentistry for which a health profession specialty field
- 28 license under this section does not exist.
- 29 (6) (5) For purposes of the administration of the general

- 1 rules of the board in the Michigan Administrative Code, a reference
- 2 to specialty certification is a reference to a health profession
- 3 specialty field license.
