June 24, 2025, Introduced by Reps. B. Carter and Fitzgerald and referred to Committee on Insurance.

A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled "The insurance code of 1956," by amending section 2082 (MCL 500.2082).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2082. (1) No A life insurer doing business in this state
- 2 shall not make any distinction or discrimination between white
- 3 persons and colored persons, wholly or partially of African
- 4 descent, individuals based on race or color as to the premiums or
- 5 rates charged for policies upon on the lives of such persons, those
- 6 individuals, or in any other manner. whatever; nor shall any such A

- 1 life insurer doing business in this state shall not demand or
- 2 require a greater premium from such colored persons than is at that
- 3 time required by such insurer from white persons of the same age,
- 4 sex, general condition of health and prospect of longevity; nor an
- 5 individual based on that individual's race or color. A life insurer
- 6 doing business in this state shall not make or require any a
- 7 rebate, diminution, or discount upon on the amount to be paid on
- 8 such a life insurance policy in case of death of such colored
- 9 person insured; nor based on an individual's race or color or
- 10 insert in the policy any a condition, nor or make any a stipulation
- 11 whereby such person by which the insured shall bind himself
- 12 individual binds the individual or his—the individual's heirs,
- 13 executors, administrators personal representatives, and assigns to
- 14 accept any sum an amount less than the full amount or value of such
- 15 the policy in case of for a claim accruing thereon by reason
- 16 because of the death of such person—the insured , other than such
- 17 as are imposed on white persons in similar cases; individual, based
- 18 on the individual's race or color, and any such stipulations
- 19 stipulation or conditions condition so made or inserted shall be is

- 21 (2) Any An insurer which that violates any of the provisions
- 22 of this section shall forfeit to the state the sum of \$500.00 is
- 23 subject to a civil fine of \$1,000.00 for each violation, to be
- 24 recovered by the attorney general by appropriate action in any a
- 25 court, of competent jurisdiction, and any a judgment therefor from
- 26 the action may be collected in the same manner as is herein
- 27 provided for collecting judgments rendered in favor of
