A bill to amend 2008 PA 295, entitled "Clean and renewable energy and energy waste reduction act," (MCL 460.1001 to 460.1232) by amending the title, as amended by 2023 PA 235, and by adding section 55.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

TITLE

2 An act to require certain providers of electric service to establish and recover costs for renewable energy and clean energy programs; to require certain providers of electric or natural gas service to establish, and recover costs for, energy waste reduction

- 28 (2) Renewable energy credits shall not be granted for
- 29 electricity generated by a wind turbine constructed in violation of

- 1 subsection (1)(a).
- 2 (3) The attorney general may bring an action for injunctive
- 3 relief for a violation of this section.
