A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled "The social welfare act," by amending section 46 (MCL 400.46).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 46. (1) The administration of the powers and duties of
- 2 the county department shall be is vested in a county social
- 3 services board of 3 members, appointed from persons individuals
- 4 residing within the county, and not holding an elective office, for

- (2) Members appointed before October 27, 1965 —shall continue in office until the expiration of their the members' terms and until successors are appointed and qualified. Each member shall qualify by taking and filing with the county clerk the

- 24 for the transaction of business. The board shall meet on the call

- 28 than 12 meetings each fiscal year with an interval of not more than
- 29 5 weeks between 2 meetings.

 - (5) (4)—If a member of the county social services board, upon receiving notification, fails to attend 3 consecutive regularly scheduled meetings of the board, the county board of commissioners after notification from the county social services board of the failure of a member to attend without reasonable cause such as illness or other circumstances beyond the member's control shall by formal vote excuse the member or declare the office vacant. The vacancy shall—must be filled for the remainder of the unexpired term in the same manner as the original appointment was made.
 - (6) (5) Members of the board shall be reimbursed for necessary travel and other expenses, and shall be paid such an amount as shall be that is fixed by the county board of commissioners or board of county auditors.
