## **SENATE BILL NO. 138**

March 12, 2025, Introduced by Senators MOSS, GEISS, BAYER, WOJNO, KLINEFELT, CHANG, CAVANAGH, MCCANN, MCMORROW and SHINK and referred to Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 227 (MCL 257.227), as amended by 2011 PA 92.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 227. (1) Application for renewal of a vehicle
- 2 registration shall must be made by the owner upon on proper
- 3 application and by payment of the registration fee for the vehicle,
- 4 as provided by law.
- 5 (2) Every application shall must be accompanied by the
- 6 certificate of title pertaining to the vehicle, showing ownership

- in the person applying for registration at the time of the
  application. The secretary of state may waive the presentation of
  the certificate of title.
  - (3) Every application for renewal of a motor vehicle registration shall must be accompanied by proof of vehicle insurance in a form determined by the secretary of state.
- 7 (4) Notwithstanding subsection (3), the secretary of state shall accept as proof of vehicle insurance a transmission of the 8 9 applicant's vehicle policy information for an insured vehicle for 10 which vehicle registration is sought. The secretary of state may 11 determine in what format and on what timeline the secretary of 12 state will receive vehicle policy information, which shall must not be required more frequently than every 14 days. In determining the 13 14 format under this subsection, the secretary of state shall consult 15 with insurers. The transmission to the secretary of state of the 16 vehicle policy information is proof of insurance to the secretary of state for motor vehicle registration purposes only and is not 17 18 evidence that a policy of insurance actually exists between an insurer and an individual. Vehicle policy information submitted by 19 20 an insurer and received by the secretary of state under this subsection is confidential, is not subject to the freedom of 21 information act, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231 to 15.246, and shall must 22 23 not be disclosed to any person except the department of community health and human services for purposes of 2006 PA 593, MCL 550.281 24 25 to 550.289, or under an order by a court of competent jurisdiction in connection with a claim or fraud investigation or prosecution. 26
  - (5) If the applicant's current vehicle registration will expire before the applicant's receipt of a registration plate, the secretary of state may issue a temporary registration permit to a

- 1 person that submits an application and the proper fees and any
- 2 required donation for a registration plate under this act. The
- 3 temporary registration permit expires on the date the applicant
- 4 receives the registration plate or 60 days after the date of
- 5 issuance of the temporary registration permit, whichever occurs
- 6 first. A temporary registration permit issued under this section
- 7 must be issued without charge.
- 8 (6) As used in this section, "policy information" means the
- 9 information an automobile insurer is required to supply to the
- 10 secretary of state under section 3101a of the insurance code of
- 11 1956, 1956 PA 218, MCL 500.3101a.
