April 22, 2025, Introduced by Senators POLEHANKI, MCMORROW and GEISS and referred to Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1304.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1304. (1) Beginning with the 2025-2026 school year, the
- 2 board of a school district or board of directors of a public school
- 3 academy shall develop and implement wireless communications device
- 4 policies for elementary schools, middle schools, and high schools
- 5 operated by the board or board of directors. A wireless

- 1 communications device policy implemented under this section must
- 2 seek to limit student cell phone use during school hours and reduce
- 3 wireless communication device-related distractions in classroom
- 4 settings, and may prohibit students from using a wireless
- 5 communications device on school grounds during any of the
- 6 following, as applicable:
- 7 (a) Instructional time.
- 8 (b) Breaks between instructional time.
- 9 (c) Lunch.
- 10 (d) Recess.
- 11 (2) The board of a school district or the board of directors
- 12 of a public school academy may implement additional restrictions
- 13 regarding the use of wireless communications devices.
- 14 (3) A wireless communications device policy implemented under
- 15 this section must provide exceptions for emergency situations,
- 16 devices necessary for medical use, and devices included in an
- 17 individualized education program. The policy must also allow for
- 18 the principal or chief administrator of a public school to
- 19 implement further exceptions at the principal's or chief
- 20 administrator's discretion.
- 21 (4) The board of a school district or board of directors of a
- 22 public school academy shall post the wireless communications device
- 23 policy implemented under this section on the school district's or
- 24 public school academy's website.
- 25 (5) As used in this section:
- 26 (a) "School grounds" means a building, playing field, or
- 27 property used for school purposes to impart instruction to children
- 28 or used for functions and events sponsored by a school. School
- 29 grounds does not include a building used primarily for adult

- 1 education or college extension courses.
- 2 (b) "Wireless communications device" means an electronic
- 3 device capable of, but not limited to, text messaging, voice
- 4 communication, entertainment, navigation, accessing the internet,
- 5 or producing email.
