## **SENATE BILL NO. 309**

May 15, 2025, Introduced by Senator SANTANA and referred to Committee on Housing and Human Services.

A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled "The social welfare act,"

(MCL 400.1 to 400.119b) by adding section 104.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 104. (1) Beginning on the effective date of the
- 2 amendatory act that added this section and subject to
- 3 appropriation, the department shall establish and administer the Rx
- 4 Kids program to improve the economic stability of households with
- 5 very young children.
- 6 (2) The department shall administer the Rx Kids program to

- 1 accomplish both of the following:
- 2 (a) Provide conditional cash allowances to each expectant
- 3 mother who resides in the Rx Kids program service area and meets
- 4 the Rx Kids program income-eligibility requirements.
- 5 (b) Provide monthly payments to each household with at least 1
- 6 child who is less than 1 year of age who resides in the Rx Kids
- 7 program service area and meets the Rx Kids program income-
- 8 eligibility requirements. Each monthly payment made for each
- 9 household under this subdivision must begin at the date of the
- 10 birth of a qualifying child for up to at least 6 months of age but
- 11 not more than 12 months of age for the qualifying child.
- 12 (3) The department shall do both of the following:
- (a) Establish income and asset levels for eligibility, types
- 14 of income and assets to be considered in making eligibility
- 15 determinations, and composition of the Rx Kids program group.
- 16 Notwithstanding this subdivision, an individual who is eligible for
- 17 medical assistance may be eligible for the Rx Kids program if the
- 18 individual meets the eligibility requirements established by the
- 19 department.
- 20 (b) Contract with third-party organizations to administer the
- 21 Rx Kids program.
- 22 (4) The department shall administer the Rx Kids program in an
- 23 Rx Kids program service area that has raised 2 years of matching
- 24 funds for the program. The department may create and administer the
- 25 Rx Kids program to an area that is not an Rx Kids program service
- 26 area only if the legislature has appropriated an amount sufficient
- 27 to operate the Rx Kids program in that area.
- 28 (5) The department shall cap the cost of administering the Rx
- 29 Kids program at 5% of the costs of the Rx Kids program.

- 1 (6) As used in this section:
- 2 (a) "Local unit of government" means a county, township, city,
  3 or village.
- 4 (b) "Rx Kids program" means a program of Michigan State
- 5 University Pediatric Public Health Initiative, in collaboration
- 6 with Poverty Solutions at the University of Michigan, and
- 7 administered by GiveDirectly.
- 8 (c) "Rx Kids program service area" means a local unit of
- 9 government that operated the Rx Kids program before the effective
- 10 date of the amendatory act that added this section.
