

# SENATE BILL NO. 318

May 20, 2025, Introduced by Senators SANTANA, IRWIN, BAYER, CAVANAGH, SHINK, CHANG, GEISS and DAMOOSE and referred to Committee on Finance, Insurance, and Consumer Protection.

A bill to amend 1953 PA 232, entitled  
"Corrections code of 1953,"  
by amending section 67a (MCL 791.267a), as added by 1996 PA 234.

## **THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1       Sec. 67a. ~~(1) A prisoner who receives nonemergency medical,~~  
2   ~~dental, or optometric services at his or her request is responsible~~  
3   ~~for a copayment fee to the department for those services, as~~  
4   ~~determined by the department. If the prisoner is a minor, the~~  
5   ~~prisoner's parent or guardian is also responsible for a copayment~~  
6   ~~fee imposed under this section.~~

1       (1) ~~(2)~~ A prisoner who intentionally injures himself or  
2 herself, and receives emergency medical care for that injury, is  
3 responsible for the entire cost of the medical care. ~~, rather than~~  
4 ~~the copayment described in subsection (1).~~

5       (2) ~~(3)~~ The department shall determine whether those prisoners  
6 who injure themselves intentionally ~~shall~~ **will** be housed in a  
7 facility designed to allow on-site medical treatment of those  
8 injuries. Not later than ~~6 months after the effective date of this~~  
9 ~~section,~~ **September 30, 1997**, the director of the department shall  
10 report to the legislature on the feasibility and cost of  
11 implementing this subsection.
